Do you know?

106.07 Reports; certification and filing.—

Subsection (e) governs "The filing officer shall provide each candidate with a schedule designating the beginning and end of reporting periods as well as the corresponding designated due dates."

Therefore, we need to know how to set up the calendar for campaign reporting!!

REPORT TYPES:

It is not necessary to have the year before the reporting type, this is only used for candidates filing reports with the Division of Elections that are required to file by means of the Electronic Filing System.

^{*} If not reported as individual contributions when received, a political committee must report contributions that comprise multiple uniform contributions from the same person aggregating no more than \$250 per calendar year, collected by an organization that is the affiliated sponsor of the political committee. The report must list the name, address, and occupation of the person the person to the person to

REPORT TYPES continued:

The <u>monthly</u> report type begins with **M** (signifying it is a monthly report), followed by the number of the month. Example: <u>M1</u> is for reporting the month of January; <u>M2</u> is for reporting the month of February; and so on.

The F1, F2 and F3 (signifying it is a first primary report) reports are submitted before the <u>first primary</u>. 60th day immediately preceding the primary election, and biweekly on each Friday thereafter, until the G report types are due.

G1, G2, and G3 (signifying it is a general election report) reports are just before the <u>general</u> election. The 4th day immediately preceding the general election, with additional reports due on the 25th and 11th days before the primary election and the general election.

TR indicates a <u>termination report</u> (signifying it is the final/last report), which must be filed at the end of a campaign.

PLEASE NOTE: Special election reports should be indicated with the same codes as above, except an "S" should be added in front of the code (example: SG3).

REPORT TYPES CONTINUED:

If you $\underline{\text{do not}}$ have a Primary Election, you will have 3 report types:

M for Monthly
G for General
TR for Termination

Besides formulating monthly reporting dates, there are only 4 additional reporting dates to formulate. 3 G's and the TR!

If you have a Primary Election, you will have 4 report types:

M for Monthly
F for First Primary
G for General
TR for Termination

Besides formulating monthly reporting dates, there are only 7 additional reporting dates to formulate. 3 F's, 3 G's and the TR!

How easy is that!!

WHEN REPORTS ARE DUE

106.07 Reports; certification and filing.—

Monthly Reporting: (1) Each campaign treasurer designated by a candidate or political committee pursuant to s.106.021 shall file regular reports of all contributions received, and all expenditures made, by or on behalf of such candidate or political committee. *Except as provided in paragraphs (a) and (b)*, reports shall be filed on the 10th day following the end of each calendar month from the time the campaign treasurer is appointed, except that, if the 10th day following the end of a calendar month occurs on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the report shall be filed on the next following day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday.

WHEN REPORTS ARE DUE - CONTINUED

106.07 Reports; certification and filing.—

"F" reporting is only for those municipalities having a **primary** election

Types "F" and "G" Reports:

(b) Any other candidate [this applies to municipal candidates] or a political committee required to file reports with a filing officer other than the division must file reports on the 60th day immediately preceding the primary election, and biweekly on each Friday thereafter through and including

the 4th day immediately preceding the general election, with additional reports due on the 25th and 11th days before the primary election and the general election.

"G" reporting is for the general election.

WHEN REPORTS ARE DUE - CONTINUED

Municipal Campaign Finance Reporting Dates Chapter 2013-37, Laws of Florida (HB 569)

The new law, effective November 1, 2013, amends sections 106.07 and 106.0703, Florida Statutes, to provide that any candidate, political committee or ECO not filing with the Division must file monthly reports, as well as "reports on the 60th day immediately preceding the primary election, and biweekly on each Friday thereafter through and including the 4th day immediately preceding the general election, with additional reports due on the 25th and 11th days before the primary and the general election."

Consistent with Division of Elections Formal Opinion 98-03, for municipal elections in which NO municipal Primary is held, the only applicable reporting dates other than monthly reports are those reports due on the 25th, 11th, and 4th days preceding the municipal general election.

TIME REPORTS ARE DUE Reports; certification and filing,-106.07 What time are reports due? (2)(a)1. Except as provided in s. 106.0705, reports shall be filed not later than 5 p.m. of the day designated; 05/28/2015

REPORTING PERIOD ENDING DATES

106.07 Reports; certification and filing.—

For Monthly Reports - (1) Monthly reports shall include all contributions received and expenditures made during the calendar month; and

For "F" and "G" Reports - (2)(a)1. of the day designated; Reports must contain information on all previously unreported contributions received and expenditures made as of the preceding Friday,

EXCEPT that the <u>report filed on the Friday immediately preceding the election</u> must contain information on all previously unreported contributions received and expenditures made as of <u>the day preceding that designated due</u> date;

CONTRIBUTION DEADLINE

106.08 Contributions; limitations on.—

(3)(a) Any contribution received by a candidate with opposition in an election or by the campaign treasurer or a deputy campaign treasurer of such a candidate on the day of that election or less than 5 days before the day of that election must be returned by him or her to the person or committee contributing it and may not be used or expended by or on behalf of the candidate.

OR

(3)(b) Any contribution received by a candidate or by the campaign treasurer or a deputy campaign treasurer of a candidate **after the date** at which the <u>candidate</u> <u>withdraws</u> his or her candidacy, or <u>after the date the candidate is defeated</u>, becomes <u>unopposed</u>, must be returned to the person or committee contributing it and may not be used or expended by or on behalf of the candidate.

This portion relates to primary elections, not general elections.

EXPENDITURE DEADLINE

106.07 Reports; certification and filing.—

(2)(a)1. All reports required of a candidate by this section shall be filed with the officer before whom the candidate is required by law to qualify. Except as provided in s. 106.0705, reports shall be filed not later than 5 p.m. of the day designated; Reports other than daily reports must contain information on all previously unreported contributions received and expenditures made as of the preceding Friday, except that the report filed on the Friday immediately preceding the election must contain information on all previously unreported contributions received and expenditures made as of the day preceding that designated due date;

TERMINATION DEADLINE

106.07 Reports; certification and filing.—

(1)(c) Following the last day of qualifying for office, any unopposed candidate need only file a report within 90 days after the date such candidate became unopposed. Such report shall contain all previously unreported contributions and expenditures as required by this section and shall reflect disposition of funds as required by s. 106.141.

OR

106.141 Disposition of surplus funds by candidates.—

(1) Each candidate who withdraws his or her candidacy, becomes an unopposed candidate, or is eliminated as a candidate or elected to office shall, within 90 days, dispose of the funds on deposit in his or her campaign account and file a report reflecting the disposition of all remaining funds. Such candidate shall not accept any contributions, nor shall any person accept contributions on behalf of such candidate, after the candidate withdraws his or her candidacy, becomes unopposed, or is eliminated or elected.
