- **>460 miles** of fiber-optic cable
- **>10,000** AT&T Leased Circuits
- **425** connected facilities
- **14,000** connected devices
- **>10,000** phones (VoIP >2,500)
- **87** phone-related systems
- **3,000,000+** public WiFi sessions per month
- **Broad customer base** – entire County government and over 40 external agency agreements



Phased Implementation Boundaries


- 1** North, 25th Street; South, 18th Street, East, Dixie Hwy, West, Railroad Tracks

- **Application Development** — (e.g., ID code violations by PAPA System property control #)
- **Existing Business Applications** — Human Resources System; Planning, Zoning & Building
- **GIS Hosting and Support** — GIS Service Bureau, *myGeoNav* - <http://maps.co.palm-beach.fl.us/gis/mygeonav.aspx?>
- **Disaster Recovery** — new regional data center; connectivity to remote backup sites
- **Document Scanning** — document pickup, prep, scanning & destruction
- **Unified Communications Platform** — VoIP phones, video conferencing, messaging
